In my final year, I joined a pune basd company as a Cybersecurity Auditor, where I witnessed how easily people lost their hard earned money to digital fraud due to lack of awareness. This inspired me to dive deeper into research and, after a year, I left my job in 2019 to assist local police with cybercrime investigations.

Seeing the need for public awareness, I formed a team of cybersecurity enthusiasts. We conducted awareness drives in schools and local communities while continuing to support investigations. This team later became Team Hash Foundation, which was officially registered as an Non Profit Organisation on August 3, 2022. Enabled teachers and volunteers to continue cyber awareness education sustainably.

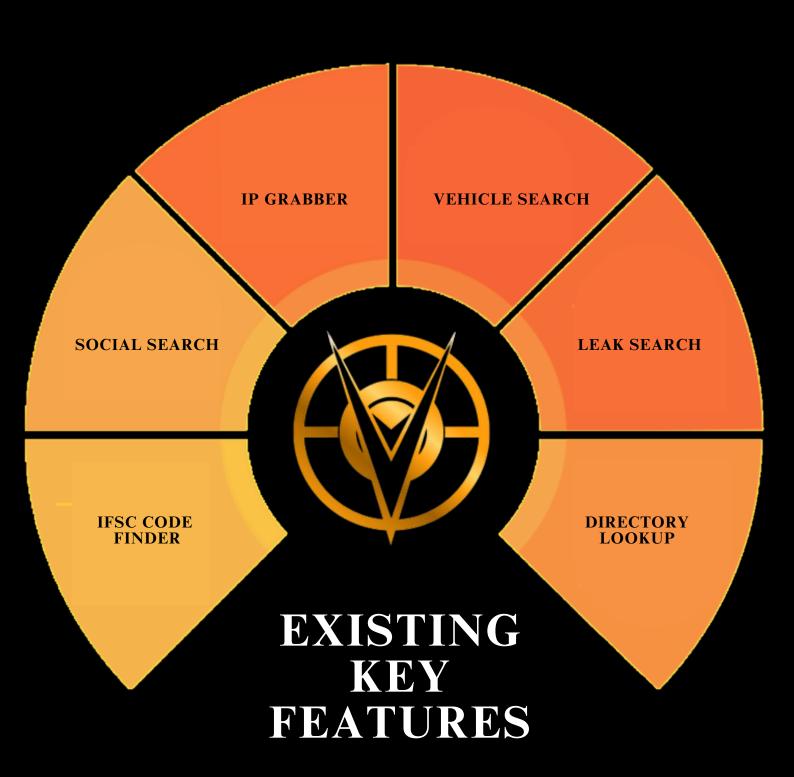
### BEHAVIORAL CHANGE

# **Cyber Cop App**

Cyber Cop, an opensource intelligence tool by Shivam Singh, has revolutionized cybercrime investigations since late 2022. It offers features like IP tracing, vehicle and tower searches, and social media searches. By March 2023, the application was fully developed, allowing ongoing community enhancements. This tool is a major advancement in fighting cybercrime.





### **CONCLUSIONS**

The Annual Report 2022-2023 of Team Hash Foundation highlights our impactful work in promoting cyber safety across Rajasthan through our awareness run 2019-2020. The organization educated over 7,000 students from government and private schools and colleges via workshops, webinars, and digital literacy drives. We empowered educators through training sessions and awareness programmes, helping to expand our reach to remote areas. A major acproject was the launch and success of the Cyber Cop app, a tool aiding law enforcement in tackling cybercrime and solving Cybercrimes. The report also notes a significant rise in app downloads, donations, and law enforcement engagement, along with measurable outcomes like reduced cyberbullying and increased community awareness.
